

REPSONSE TO QUESTIONS Planning and Engineering Services

For Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission Stormwater Mitigation Projects

February 26, 2019

Please find below the answers to questions received in regards to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) posted on February 15, 2019 by the Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission (CVRPC) for the following:

- Project development (scoping) and technical assistance
- Stormwater planning, design, engineering, and construction management for stormwater mitigation projects.
- 1. Will CVRPC accept cost proposals that include standard annual rate increases (i.e. inflation) over the duration of the contract?

No, CVRPC is looking for flat fee rates over the life of the three-year contract period. Rates can be renegotiated at the time of renewal of the contract.

2. On page 3, the second paragraph under "Stormwater Mitigation Project Implementation" refers to "circulation and area wide studies", which feels like a holdover from a previous RFQ document. Are respondents expected to address their qualifications in completing circulation and/or area wide transportation studies in their submittals?

This was an error of inclusion in the RFQ. There will be no circulation and area wide studies addressing congestions and safety issues of transportation facilities and corridors. This was language inadvertently copied from a transportation RFQ. Please disregard the second paragraph on page 3 under Stormwater Mitigation Project Implementation.
